
Digital Agriculture Hackathon 2020, Day-2

Consolidate your files, delete unnecessary images, create a CSS image sprite or convert the images to Base64 code.

2. Image Optimization

It is an important aspect, reducing the size of the image can increase the page speed by 80 percent.

3. Use CDN

It allows the quick transfer of HTML pages, style sheets, images, videos, and JavaScript files.

4. Merge Files

Merge CSS and JavaScript files. One HTTP connection downloading the file is usually faster than multiple HTTP connections downloading files.

5. Enable Application Caching

After activating caching, users can navigate a site even when they are offline. Cached resources are local and therefore load faster.

 It superimposes a series of lines on your smartphone's screen that are based on the "rule of thirds".
- 2. Set your camera's focus.

 To adjust your camera's lens to focus, tap

the screen where you want to sharpen the view.

3. Look for symmetry.


Pictures that contain symmetry can be incredibly pleasing to the eye. Remember to use those gridlines from tip #1 to line up everything perfectly.

4. Avoid zooming in.

Zooming can make the photo appear blurry or pixelated. Instead, take the photo from a default distance, and crop it later.

5. Don't be afraid to edit.

Editing is a critical element for better pictures. Filters can be a valuable photographic tool, particularly for two goals - removing blemishes from a picture & adding vibrance.





