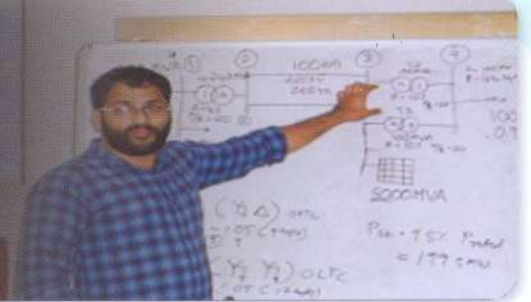


FDPs and Workshops

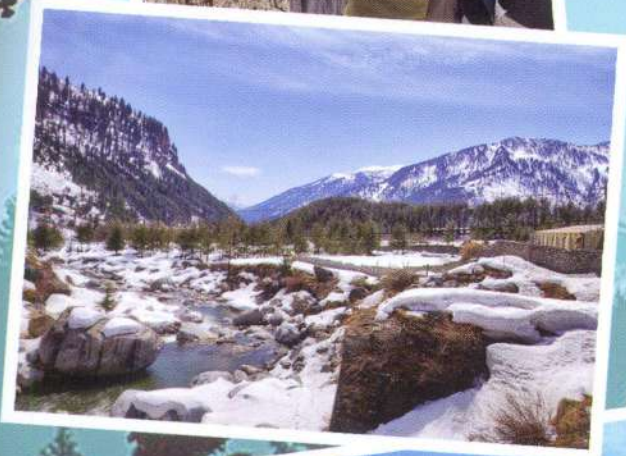
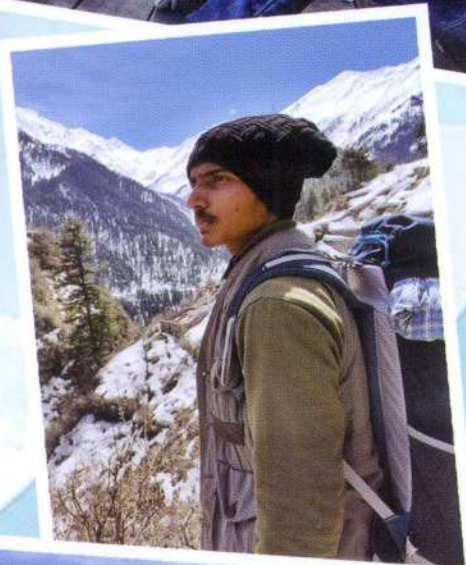
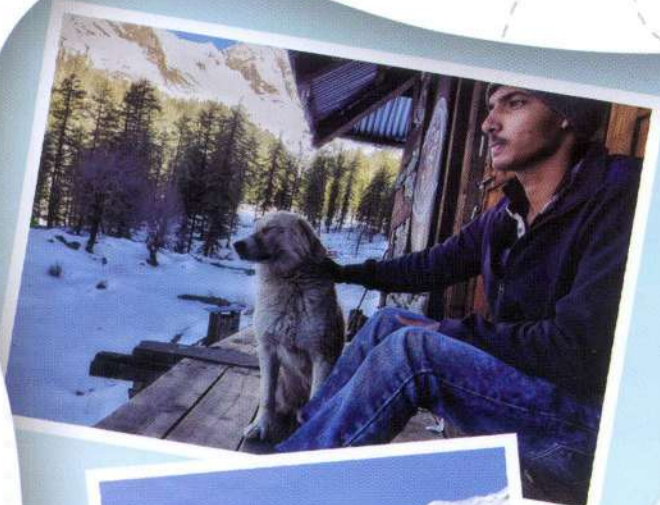
Kedarkantha in the winter is an amazing trek for those who want to trek in snow and those who want to reach the summit of the peak. Kedarkantha is not just any ordinary trek, it's a summit trek. You only get to return to the starting point after you reach the summit. There's no heading back in between.

It was a challenging trek for me in the extremely cold weather but it was a challenge that I was up for. It was a three night- four day trek, and had three base camps to reach, Sankri base village (6,400ft), Juda ka Talab (9,400ft), before reaching the summit of Kedharkantha of 12,500ft.

Not many know this but on the Kedarkantha trek, you will probably come across snow just as you cross the 7,000 feet mark, lying on the forest floor among the pine trees. When you reach the meadows, it is likely to be a huge blanket of white around you in every direction.

On the last day, waking up at 2:00 AM at -17°C to reach the summit before sunrise was the only goal we were walking forward for. Reaching the Kedarkantha summit was one of the biggest challenges with the piercing winds hitting us, lots of energy drain with very less water to keep ourselves hydrated. But in the end, the stunning view was definitely worth it.
