

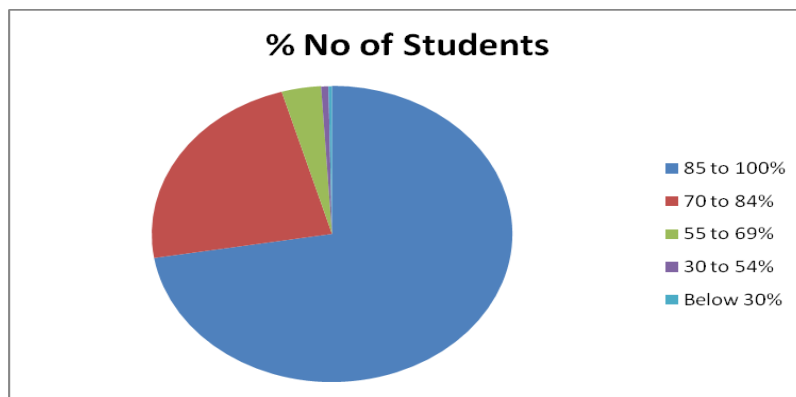

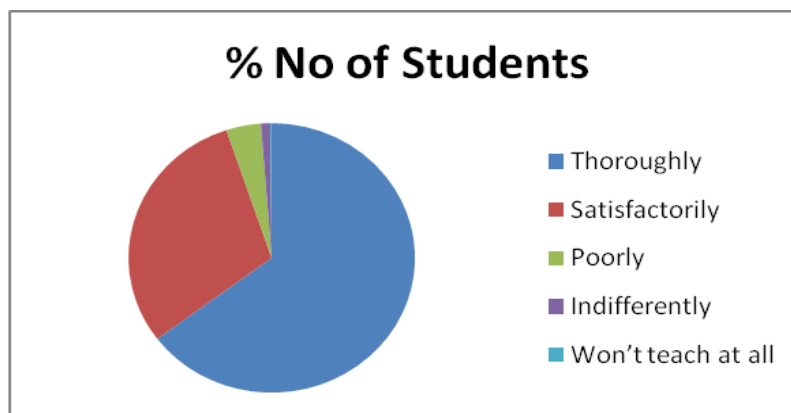
#### 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

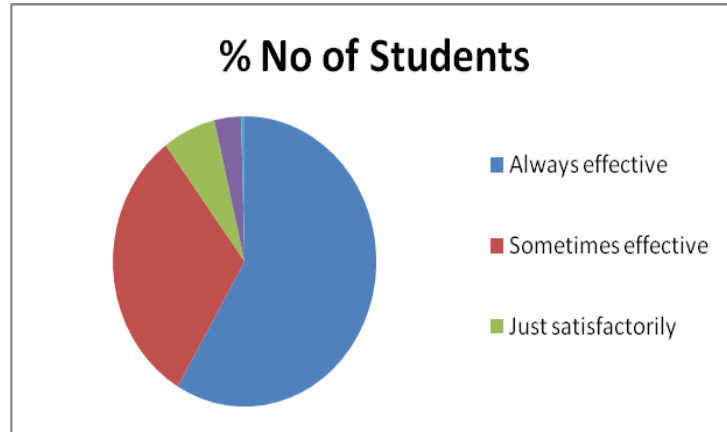
#### 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

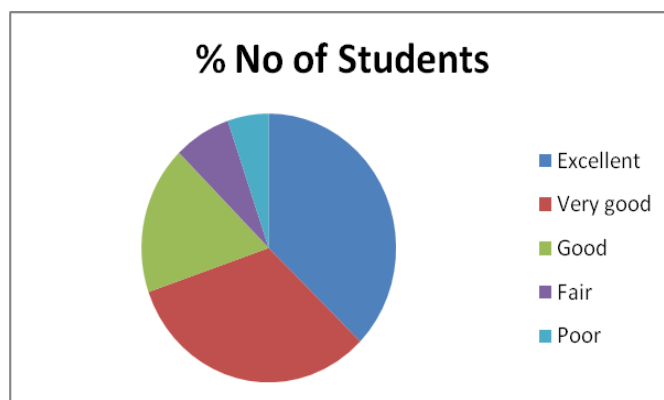
### 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

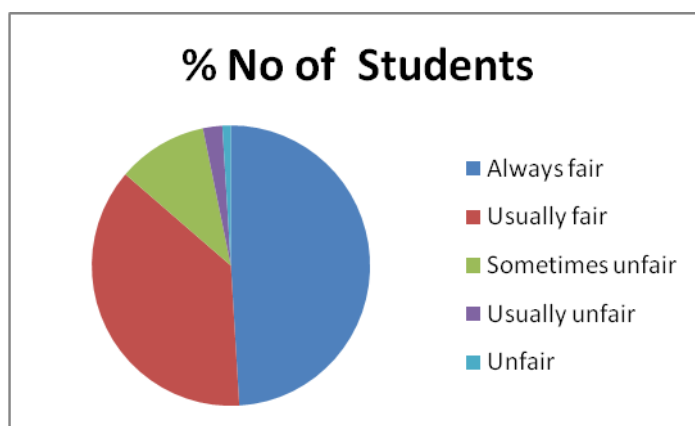
### 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

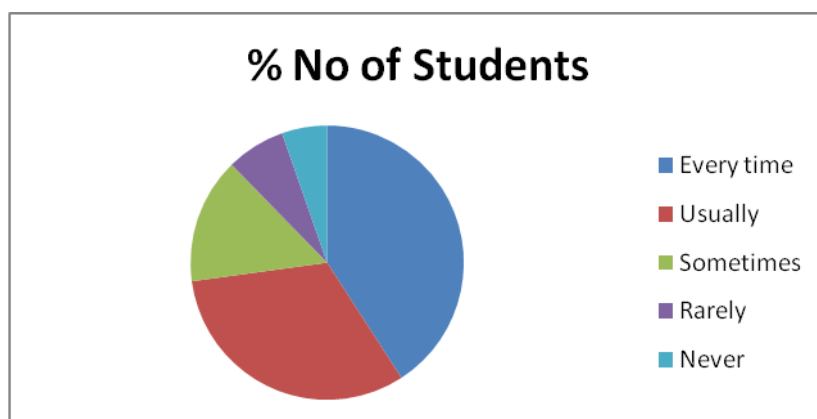

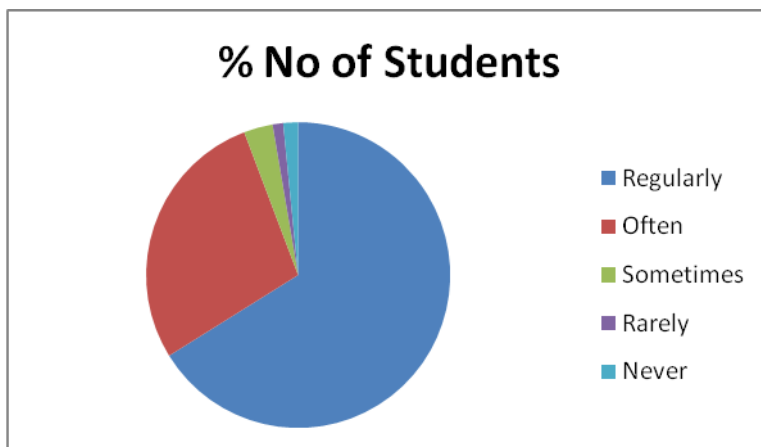

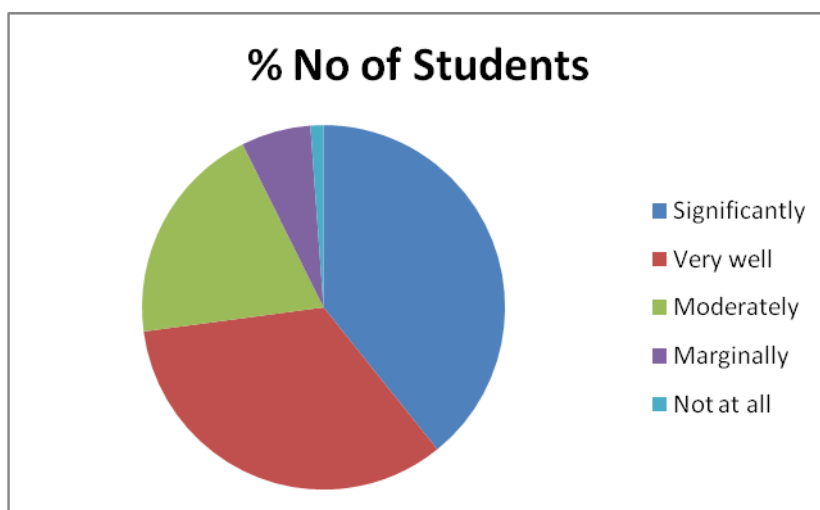

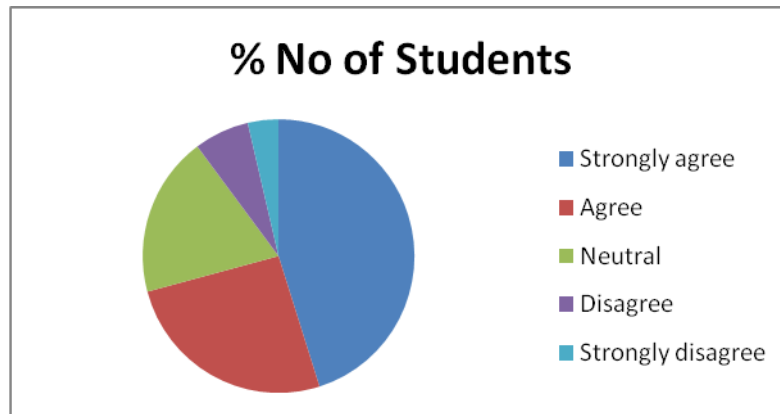
**8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you incognitive, social and emotional growth**

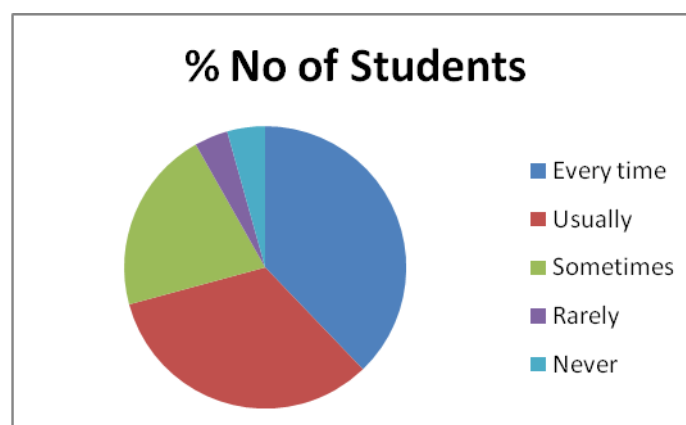

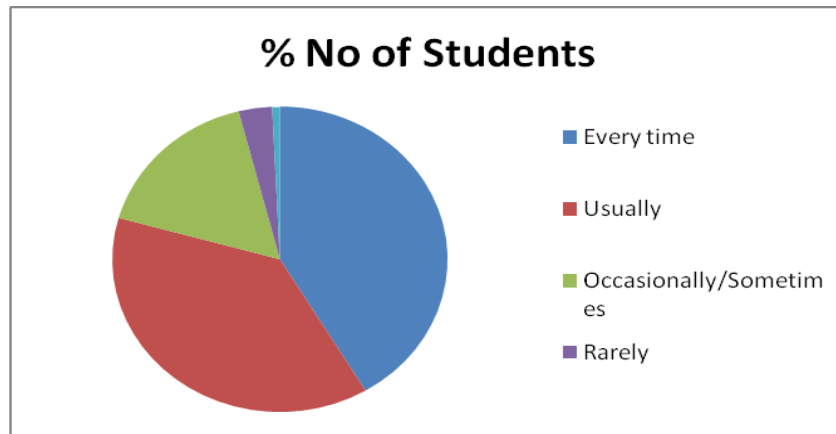

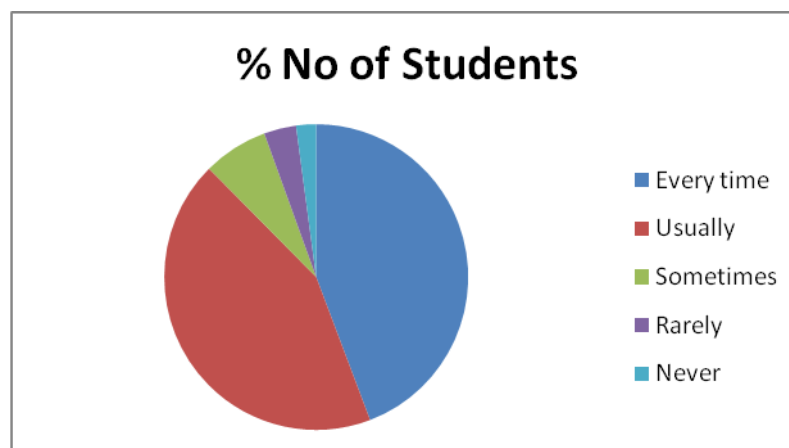

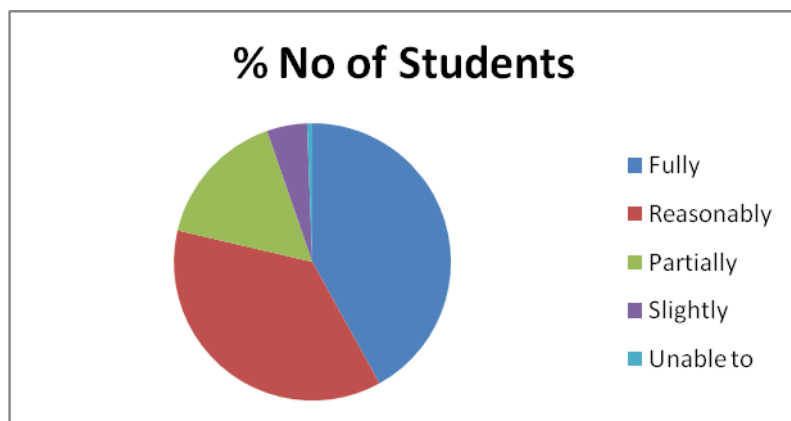
**12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.**

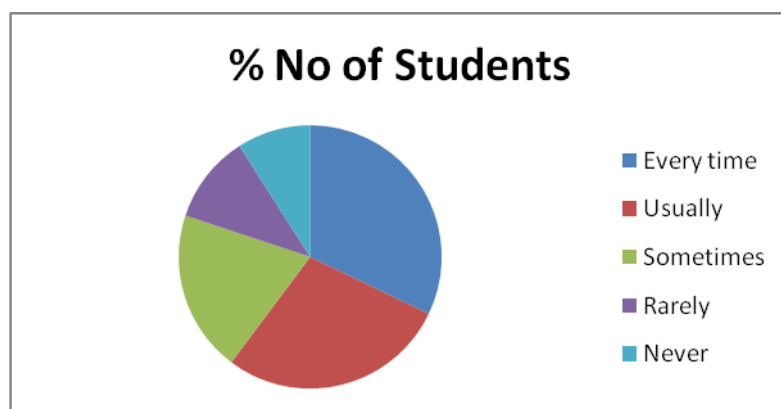

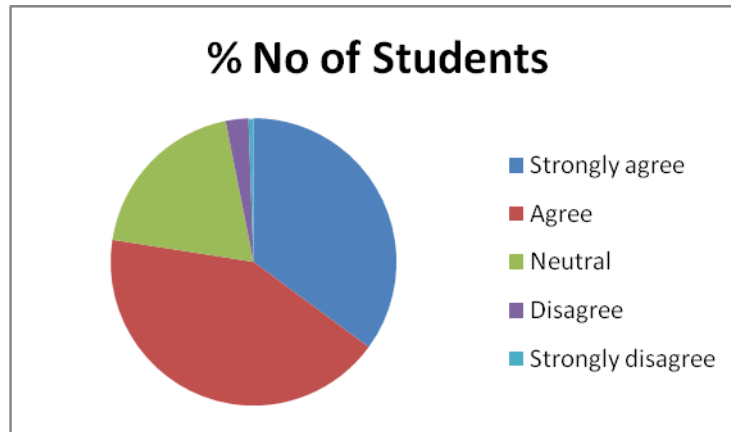

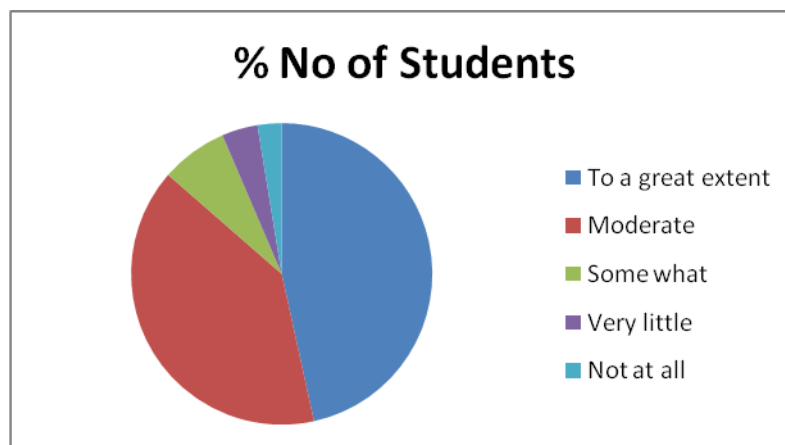
**15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.**

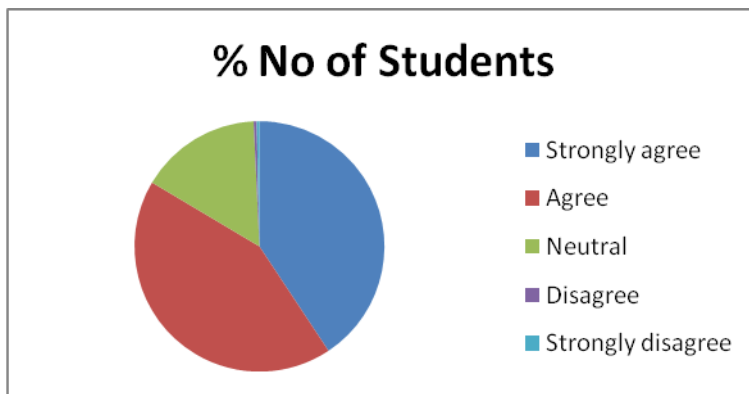

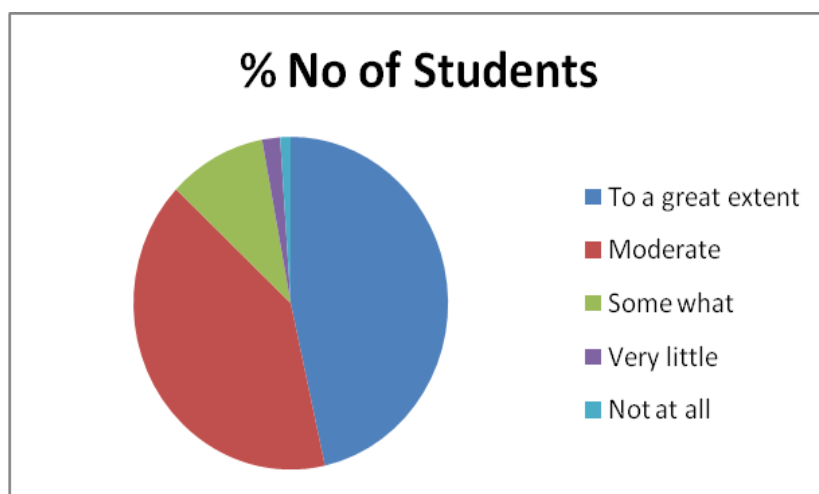
**17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities**

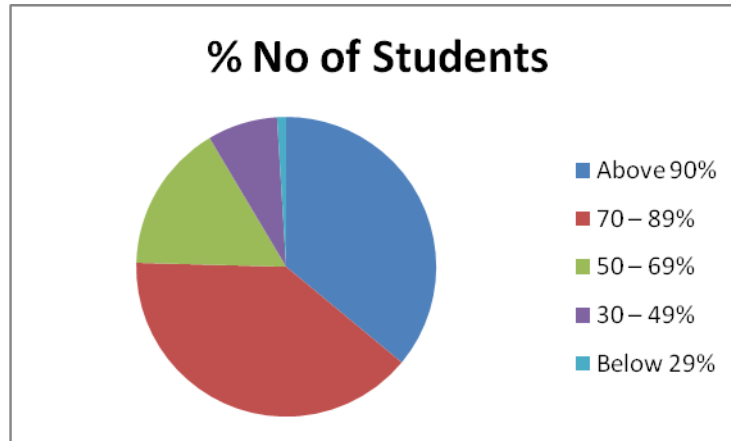
